<u>Notes</u> Dose was drafted by the Eagles and played a key role hitting .452 in Winthrop's 2003 state tourney run, only their second and first since 1956...Loverrude, a GFW High School alumnus along with most of the Eagles' roster, was also drafted by Winthrop last season...The Eagles have played Belle Plaine five times in playoff action, winning three, but the Tigers have won the past two, a key 1-0 state-qualifying game in 2008 and a 5-3 win in the regions last year ...Dan Anderson is on pace for his 13th season over .300 and has a shot at his 6th .400-plus BA...Bill Melius set an Eagle pitching record with his 7th mound win...	<u>Notes</u> The Saints defeated Winthrop four times during the season...Going into the 2010 playoff season, the Eagles had held a 4-3 edge in post-season games vs. the Saints...Player-Mgr. Tom Lacina, at 52, was the winning pitcher earlier in the season when the Saints beat the Eagles by a 9-6 margin. He also pitches in an over-35 league and annually goes to Florida for a national senior tourney...Billy Hanson was catcher for Gustavus this spring and hit .356...	<u>Notes</u> The Tigers have slugged 9 homers this year, including 3 by Pat Schultz...Rob Wagener -- a 2004 Winthrop Eagle draftee -- has not allowed an earned run in 34 IP this year. He played for Waconia the past several years...BP has won 12 of 13, and 16 of their last 18... Dan Huber and Matt Schultz have played in all 35 games this year, each at five positions... LHP Adam Johnson started the season 0-2, but has won 9 consecutive decisions and saved a pair of games to boot, including the 5-3 win over the Eagles in Winthrop...
